Smaller FK250L8 'Alley Cat' Top Loaders collect food waste from inner-city locations, FN2428 curtain siders cart pallets from businesses around Auckland back to the EcoStock processing facility, an FM1628 rear loader services supermarkets, and an FK250H8 gantry truck recovers bins from larger manufacturers.
